We're accustomed to obstacles here at Trust Women. Our work wouldn't be important if it were easy.

Senate Bill 1552 in Oklahoma, however, goes beyond an obstacle. It is a blatant attempt to make abortion illegal. SB 1552 would allow the state to take away the medical licenses of doctors who perform abortions. We stand ready to defend a woman's constitutional right to have access to and control over her reproductive rights. Trust Women is committed to helping women make tough decisions that should, in fact, be made by them and not by politicians.

Even though *Roe v. Wade* still stands and abortions remain legal, women must have access to abortion providers to truly make reproductive decisions for themselves. SB 1552 is an abhorrent attempt to take away a woman's legal right to choose. Without actual access to abortion, *Roe v. Wade* means little to women.

Weeks away from opening our second clinic, South Wind Women's Center in Oklahoma City, we will not be deterred by SB 1552.

Oklahoma legislators are wasting time and money by prioritizing legislation that restricts abortions over laws that support women and their families.
