



Dear Rebecca,

Right now, this minute, we have 30 patients and their loved ones in our waiting room. I'd like to tell you about Elizabeth*.

Elizabeth is a 24-year-old mother of two from Oklahoma City. Despite the cost of travel, a burden for many of our patients, she was able to get to our clinic today with about half of the money for her procedure. But she needs an additional \$450.

We never turn anyone away for an abortion based on ability to pay.

Unfortunately, Kansas and Oklahoma are states that do not allow people's private insurance to pay for abortion care. There are eight other states with similar laws on the books.

Elizabeth earns a little too much money to qualify for many of the abortion funds with which we work.

In reality, though, she makes enough to just get by, living paycheck to paycheck. She earns about \$28,000 a year, which she uses to support her two young sons.

That's what the U.S. Supreme Court just decided. Situations such as Elizabeth's are the real

reason why you and I fight for this issue. **And in the month of June, we received six times the number of funding requests we normally get in a month.**

If you think women should have access to abortion, then please consider a contribution of your most generous amount.

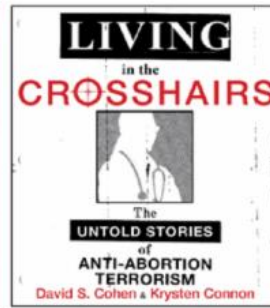
